HELPFUL HINTS

At our April meeting, members shared information about sewing tools they have found especially useful. I went right to Amazon amd ordered all the ones I didn't already have:

- Two joined needles (for spacing out counted threads)
- ➤ He I clamp scissors (for picking out threads regular Scotch tape is good for this, too!)
- Shish kebab stick
- > Two joined hoops to make a lap stand (10" + 7" and 7" + 4") by Morgan, from 123 Stitch
- > Erasable highlighters (friction)
- Magnet on an extendable stick, with a light on the end
- Highlighter tape (reusable)
- > Small portable light that snaps onto a working hoop
- And Mari reminded us of "Utube University," bottomless well of information on how to do things.
